PRODUCTION INFORMATION - OPEN CHOICE

For a fee of \$800, authors of fully-paid papers can choose to make the full contents of the final published version of their paper available to all, subscribers and non-subscribers, on the AMS Journals Online site. Authors can request Open Choice by emailing AMS Publications Coordinator Gwendolyn Whittaker (gwhittaker@ametsoc.org). The fee will be included when the paper is invoiced. Note that any AMS journal volume older than two years is free and open to all.

The entire journal database ? including accepted manuscripts not yet published (Early Online Releases(EORs)) ? is searchable by all, with access restricted to subscribers for the full-text EORs and articles from the most recent two years. Abstracts for published manuscripts and EORs are always available to nonsubscribers and subscribers alike.

PRODUCTION INFORMATION - EARLY ONLINE RELEASE

The final accepted version of your paper will be sent to press within a few weeks after acceptance for posting on AMS's Early Online Release (EOR) site (<http://journals.ametsoc.org/page/eors>). If you opted out of full EOR posting when you uploaded your final revision, your full manuscript will not be made available, but the title, abstract, and author list will be posted.

PRODUCTION INFORMATION - STATUS INQUIRIES

You can check the production status of your submission at any time by logging in to <http://mwr.edmgr.com/>. Processing times can vary, depending on the workload across all AMS journals, but generally authors should receive email from AMS Publications staff about two weeks after AMS has received the charge form. This email will either confirm that your submission has begun full production, or will give you instructions for providing anything required.
